


Visit Ancient Rock Art Sites

WET SEASON SPECTACULAR ...

Your adventure day by day

Day 1: Darwin - Mt Borradaile, Arnhem Land

Up with the birds, you'll set off on an early morning departure which will have you flying over the East Alligator River and into Arnhem Land in just on one hour.

Touch down outback style at the Borradaile airfield and enter the camp for a welcome orientation. Your hosts will ensure an authentic adventure and will share with you the treasures of Arnhem Land.

Two days here will offer numerous activities set amidst a stunning backdrop. An afternoon tour will leave you amazed at the sheer volume of water that the Wet produces, as you follow dry season roads in your boat!

Max Davidson's Mt. Borradaile Camp ensuite cabin (2 nights) Flight time 1hr

Day 2: Mount Borradaile

Mount Borradaile's 700km2 lease is renowned for its abundance of high quality cave paintings with fine examples from the Freshwater, Contact and Estuarine periods, including the majestic Rainbow Serpent – one of the most potent symbols of aboriginal spiritualism.

Expert commentary will explain why Borradaile is such a significant place. Lunch is served with a view, and more exploration to follow.

Another draw card for the Wet is that you won't be sharing the experience with many others at all. Get out on the water, up close with birds and experience an entire wetlands ecosystem.

No flight today.

Day 3: Mt Borradaile - Kakadu Falls scenic flights - Berkeley River Lodge

Following breakfast, depart skyward for an aerial exploration of Kakadu (including the Jim Jim and Twin Falls). From here, fly direct to Berkeley River Lodge, one of the last true wilderness areas on Earth and located between Timor Sea sunrises and Berkeley River sunsets.

This luxury lodge is only accessible by air and its location will literally take your breath away.



This afternoon cruise up the Berkeley River all the way to the Berkeley River Falls, that should be thundering at this time of year. Following this, enjoy sundowners before a decadent dining experience at the Dunes Restaurant.

Berkeley River Lodge (2 nights) Kimberley Villa Flight time 2hrs 30mins

Day 4: Kimberley Waterfalls

For the next two days, you'll be divided into groups to enjoy a helicopter flight up to the King George Falls and a 4WD land based tour along isolated beaches.

The majestic twin falls of King George Sound are the highest waterfalls in Western Australia, plunging an impressive 80 metres – a truly staggering scene to behold and will be epic at this time of year.

Your helicopter will land out the back of the falls to explore one of the best Bradshaw art sites in the Kimberley. We'll then follow the King George along its dramatic course to the ocean and on to the Atlantis Pools before returning home. A truly epic day!

No flight today.

Day 5: Berkeley River Lodge - Darwin

Enjoy a more leisurely start to the day with the option to go on either a fishing or walking trip. Returning to the lodge for lunch before rejoining your waiting aircraft for the flight back to Darwin.



Max Davidson's Borradaile Camp

In 1986, the late Max and Philippa Davidson negotiated with the area's traditional Ulba Bunidj people to lease 700 sq km of this pristine, Registered Sacred Site as the base for their acclaimed Davidson's Arnhemland Safaris.

The lodge itself is set amongst the woodland, you'll enjoy award winning dining and comfortable 4 star accommodation that blends in with the environment.

The property features a pool, large outdoor alfresco dining, bar, library and complimentary laundry for guests.

The area is home to more than 240 species of birds, the rare Leichhardt grasshopper, frill-necked lizards, giant estuarine crocodiles, water buffalo, dingoes and more.

Recorded on walls and inside caves in the area are some of the most colourful, prolific and oldest examples of rock art to be found anywhere in the world.

Equipped with the latest avionics with impressive safety features. The interior is spacious with a high wing and large windows making in flight viewing a joy.


