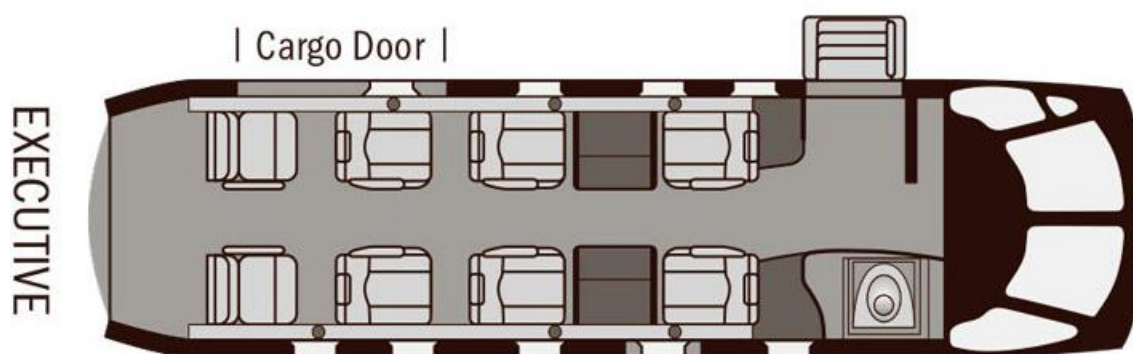
This aircraft can fly up to 2,600km without refuelling and can land on dirt airstrips as short as 850m.

Luggage allowance – 8 passengers

A strict 10kg* per person plus a small carry-on bag.

For **golf tours** a strict 10kg* per person plus a pencil golf bag (containing up to 13 clubs) and a small carry-on bag.

Luggage Allowance - less than 8 passengers

Allowance is increased if travelling with fewer passengers - up to 60kg* per person for two passengers.

* All bags must be soft sided and cannot exceed 30cm in depth (height) due to the space available in the luggage compartment.
