Unique Stay at the Famous Prairie Hotel



THE OUTBACK EXPLORER ...

Your adventure day by day

Day 1: Melbourne – Birdsville via The Dig Tree

Depart Melbourne early morning for a scenic flight that will take you north-west over the Murray River, arriving in Broken Hill for fuel and refreshments.

Next your pilot will fly you over the desert past Cameron Corner then to Nappa Merrie Station for lunch at the historic Dig Tree a site of both achievement and tragedy.

The Burke and Wills Dig Tree is one of Australia's National icons and an enduring reminder of the pioneering spirit and extreme harshness of the Outback. Located on the northern bank of Cooper Creek, the Dig Tree is a Coolibah (Eucalyptus microtha).

In 1898, John Dick carved Burke's face into another tree (the Face Tree) about 15 metres downstream of the Dig Tree. The site is as Burke and Wills and companions would have viewed it nearly 140 years ago. These trees are direct a link to the explorers of Australia's Historic Past.

Following this you'll continue to Birdsville. Here, you'll be met by your local expert guide for a private tour of this remote settlement, including the hallowed ground of the Birdsville Racetrack before venturing off-road to the largest sand dune in the Simpson Desert, 'Big Red'.

Enjoy a cold beer from your 'perch' in the iconic Birdsville Pub and absorb the outback culture. Dinner tonight is in the pub's dining room where you will meet travellers that have tackled the 'Birdsville Track'. You're sure to hear some interesting stories from them.

*Birdsville Hotel (1 night)
Flight time 3hrs 50mins (3 flights total)*

Day 2: Birdsville - Parachilna

Breakfast at Birdsville and then a short walk across street to your awaiting aircraft to continue south to Parachilna overflying the Goyder Lagoon, Strzelecki Desert and parts of the Birdsville Track.

Then be met at Leigh Creek for a private tour of Nilpena Station and the Ediacaran Fossils with a picnic lunch.

The Nilpena fossil beds are the single most important site on the planet for the discovery of Ediacaran fossils, representing the rise of first animal life on the planet, and cornerstone to the Flinders Ranges World Heritage bid.

So significant are these fossil beds, that Sir David Attenborough travelled to the region to include the Ediacara biota in his documentary 'First Life'.

After your tour, it's time to settle in to your accommodation and sunset drinks before sitting down to a specially prepared dinner showcasing bush tucker, gourmet style.

*Prairie Hotel (1 night)
Flight time 1hr 25mins (1 flight)*

Day 3: Parachilna - Melbourne

This morning you will be escorted by our good friend Ross Fargher. Ross is a fourth generation grazier and will be your guide when visiting his backyard - Nilpena Station and the famous Prairie Hotel, Parachilna, which he runs with wife Jane.

The Prairie Hotel is 500km north of Adelaide on the desert side of Flinders Ranges and is an unexpected oasis with a dramatic ancient landscape backdrop. It is an intimate retreat elegantly styled 'country chic' rooms with private lounge and courtyard areas for your exclusive use.

The in-house brewery, gallery of collectible indigenous and eclectic contemporary art, remoteness with views to rugged ranges and surreal sienna sunsets over endless red plains add to the unforgettable ambience to your stay.

Ross also knows this place like the back of his hand and loves welcoming Air Adventure guests to this unique and truly special location.

On tour you'll explore the western Flinders Ranges' beautiful gorges and desert. Spot yellow-footed rock wallabies and the watchful wedge tailed eagles circling above. Return to the Prairie Hotel in time for lunch before rejoining your private aircraft for the easy flight homeward, arriving back into Melbourne approximately 1730.



Iconic Birdsville Hotel

At the end of the Birdsville Track is the frontier town of Birdsville, one of Outback Australia's most recognised towns.

Deep in the heart of wild and isolated country, Birdsville is situated between the eastern edge of the Simpson Desert, the vast gibber plains of Sturt's Stony Desert to the south and rich Channel Country to the north.

Once a notorious place through which cattle drovers moved their stock, today a sign at the entrance to Birdsville

informs visitors the town's population is 115 – plus or minus 7,000 people - thanks to the hordes of visitors who flock here for its iconic annual events.

Birdsville is also home to the iconic Birdsville Pub and is a must for anyone travelling this region to aid getting the dust out of your throat with a cool drink in the colourful front bar.

You'll enjoy lunch on arrival and then have some time to check into your rooms. Birdsville is definitely a must-visit 'bucket list' destination for many.





The Prairie Hotel

Situated in on the western edge of the Flinders Ranges, between the Heysen Range and the desert lies the outback township of Parachilna.

Located in Parachilna (population 2) is the Prairie Hotel. Owned by Ross and Jane Fargher, this iconic outback pub has been licensed since the 1800s.

Facing out to the west, where the main road used to go - a sunset and a 'Fargher Larger' is an experience you'll never forget.

Your Aircraft

Travel is in the privately chartered Air Adventure Outback Jet, Pilatus PC-12. This prop-jet aircraft is a fast, reliable outback machine capable of landing on gravel and remote airfields where others in larger aircraft can't.

The Outback Jet is operated by Armada Aviation, which holds an Air Operators Certificate issued by CASA.. All pilots are highly experienced and carry a Commercial Pilots License.

It's equipped with state-of-the-art avionics and is all weather rated with impressive safety features. The interior is spacious with custom leather seating, climate control and clear windows (every seat is the window seat) making in flight viewing a joy.


