WET SEASON SPECTACULAR ...

Your adventure day by day

Day 1: Darwin - Litchfield National Park - Nitmiluk

This morning we leave Darwin and travel into the heart of the Top End, arriving directly into **Litchfield National Park**. Known for its accessible waterfalls and clear plunge pools, Litchfield is one of the few places where the wet season invites exploration rather than restricting it.

Accompanied by a **private local guide**, we spend the day moving on foot through monsoon forest and open woodland, visiting a selection of Litchfield's most spectacular waterfalls. There is time to swim beneath cascading water (*subject to seasonal conditions*), linger in shaded surrounds, and enjoy a relaxed picnic lunch in the park.

In the afternoon, we continue south to **Katherine**, trading waterfalls for escarpment country as we arrive in Nitmiluk (Katherine Gorge). The evening is spent settling into our lodge and unwinding after a day immersed in water and landscape.

Cicada Lodge, Nitmiluk National Park (2 nights)
Flight time: Darwin to Litchfield approx. 20 minutes; Litchfield to Katherine approx. 50 minutes

Day 2: Nitmiluk (Katherine Gorge)

Today is dedicated entirely to **Nitmiluk National Park**, a place where towering sandstone walls and seasonal water flows create one of the Top End's most dramatic landscapes.

We explore the gorge from the water on a **guided Nitmiluk Gorge shared cruise**, travelling as far upstream as conditions allow. In the late wet season, the gorge is transformed - waterfalls spill from the escarpment, vegetation is lush, and the scale of the landscape feels especially powerful.

Later, we spend time with **Jawoyn cultural hosts**, gaining insight into the deep connection between people, water and country. Through storytelling and hands-on cultural activities, this private experience brings meaning and context to the landscape we have been moving through.

The remainder of the afternoon is unhurried, allowing time to relax at the lodge or enjoy the surroundings before another night at Cicada Lodge.

No flight today.

Day 3: Nitmiluk - Kakadu Escarpment & Waterfalls - Arnhem Land

After breakfast, we return to the aircraft for one of the most spectacular flights of the journey. Flying low over Kakadu's **escarpment country**, we take in sweeping views of the landscape as it transitions from floodplain to ancient stone.

En route, we pass over **Jim Jim and Twin Falls**, which in the late wet season are best appreciated from the air — water pouring from the plateau into deep sandstone gorges below.

Continuing east, we cross into Arnhem Land, landing at the remote and remarkable **Mt Borradaile**. By late morning, we arrive at our base for the next two nights, with time to settle in and begin exploring this culturally and geographically significant landscape.

Mt Borradaile, Arnhem Land (2 nights)
Flight time: Approx. 1 hour 30 minutes (including scenic flying)

Day 4: Mt Borradaile

Mount Borradaile's 700km² lease is **renowned for its abundance of high quality cave paintings** with fine examples from the Freshwater, Contact and Estuarine periods, including the majestic **Rainbow Serpent** – one of the most potent symbols of aboriginal spiritualism.

Expert commentary will explain why Borradaile is such a significant place. Lunch is served with a view, and more exploration to follow.

Another draw card for the Wet is that you won't be sharing the experience with many others at all. Get out on the water, up close with birds and experience an entire wetlands ecosystem.

No flight today.

Day 5: Mt Borradaile - Darwin

Enjoy a more leisurely start to the day with the option to go on either a fishing or walking trip. Returning to the lodge for lunch before rejoining your waiting aircraft for the flight back to Darwin.



Max Davidson's Borradaile Camp

In 1986, the late Max and Philippa Davidson negotiated with the area's traditional Ulba Bunidj people to lease 700 sq km of this pristine, Registered Sacred Site as the base for their acclaimed Davidson's Arnhemland Safaris.

The lodge itself is set amongst the woodland, you'll enjoy award winning dining and comfortable 4 star accommodation that blends in with the environment.

The property features a pool, large outdoor alfresco dining, bar, library and complimentary laundry for guests.



Mt Borradaile

The area is home to more than 240 species of birds, the rare Leichhardt grasshopper, frill-necked lizards, giant estuarine crocodiles, water buffalo, dingoes and more.

Recorded on walls and inside caves in the area are some of the most colourful, prolific and oldest examples of rock art to be found anywhere in the world.
